- The **Social Skills Program** is intended to provide a supportive environment where children and adolescents can meet and share advice and skills with peers.
- The **Parent Group** will offer the opportunity for parents to meet in a setting that will facilitate discussion on topics related to raising a child with TS.
- The **Sibling Group** will focus on skills that allow brothers and sisters to better empathize and cope with having a family member with a neurological disorder.
